

What is FoH?

- Founded in 2007 by Lieutenant Colonel Dan Rooney,
 F-16 pilot in the USAF Oklahoma Air National Guard
- FoH provides scholarships for the children and spouses of America's fallen and disabled Service members
 - Helping those families who paid the ultimate sacrifice or disabling injury
 - Opened in 2023 to also include First Responders
- FoH New Mexico has awarded 228 scholarships in NM since its inception – 55 in 2023-24 academic yr (\$265K)
- Patriot Dinner is one of their primary fund-raising events

 Donated articles are auctioned off in a silent auction and
 old-fashioned verbal auction during dinner
- Also have a golf tournament each year
- ASM has built models to be in the auction

ASM Participation

- Initial contact by ASM in 2017 offering a model display
- Have conducted 4 model displays so far:
 - 2017, 2018, 2022, and 2023; invited to 2024
 - No displays in 2019 (small venue); 2020 and 2021 (Covid)
- Display theme:
 - "Models of Aircraft, Ships and Military Vehicles Used by the U.S. Services"
 - Includes aircraft, helicopters, armor, vehicles, missiles, figures, ships, subs, dioramas - any scale welcome
 - We are always short in modern armor and ships
 - Originally only post-911, then Korean War through present
 - Model build needs detailed on slides 18 and 19
- Venues have varied as FoH sought better locations and prices

ASM Auction Models

- Have provided 4 models for auctions all in 1/48 scale
 - 2018: Two F-16Cs by Patrick Dick and Chris Kurtze in markings of NM National Guard 154th Fighter Squadron "Tacos" – sold for \$475 total
 - 2019: A-10 model by Mike Blohm \$150
 - 2022: F-35A model by Scott Jaworski \$40

Model Build Needs - 1

- A few points and clarifications on the displays and requests for new builds:
- These model builds are owned by the builders, and would just be loaned out for the club displays when they occur, if you choose to do so
- We typically re-use the same models for the displays each year, if the loaners are OK with that
- The models do not have to be built at contest-winning standards.
 Just good enough for a display and what represents ASM well
- Our two yearly displays are:
 - Folds of Honor theme "all U.S. Services subjects from the Korean War through the Present."
 - Air Force Anniversary Ball theme "all USAF subjects from 1947 through the Present." Sometimes have an event theme (like "Evolution of Flight") and we include models for that.
 - USAF subjects are a player in both displays

Model Build Needs - 2

Here is a list of models builds/needs that we would like to use in our ASM model displays

If you have an already-built kit of these and would like to loan it, please let me know

For US Army/USMC armor/military vehicles (1/35 or 1/48):

 Humvee, M109 Paladin & M110 self-propelled howitzers, M270 Multiple Launch Rocket System, AN/TWQ Avenger Air Defense System, MIM-104 Patriot, AAV7 Amphibious Assault Vehicle

For aircraft:

- USAF: In 1/144: C-17 Globemaster III, B-52D in SEA scheme/black bottom, KC-135, B-36, C-32 (presidential transport Boeing 757). In 1/72: CH-53, AC-47, and A-37 Dragonfly (all SEA), T-6 Texan II
- US Navy/USMC: In 1/72: AD-4 Skyraider (Korea), F4U {Korea), F7U Cutlass, A5 Vigilante, S-3 Viking, A-3 Skywarrior, T-45 Goshawk, F-35B, F-35C Lightning II In 1/144: P-3 Orion, P-8 Poseidon

For US Navy ships (1/700 or 1/350): subs, carriers, cruisers, destroyers ¹⁹
