2007 New Mexico State Fair Contest Mike Blohm

There was a good turnout of models at this year's fair, with 44 total entries across the four divisions. This is up from the 2006 fair. Of significance, there were 7 Junior entries this year, while there were none in 2006. The spread of the model entries was:

Junior (11 years and below), 7; Senior Youth (12 to 17), 3; Adult (18 and above), 31, and Professional, 3. ASM members submitted 17 of the 44 entries, and there was more than one fine-looking 1/32-scale F/A-18 Blue Angels Hornet on display.

The model contest cases had center stage as you entered

huge radio-controlled P-51D Mustang from the ceiling above the display cases, which certainly called attention to our area. There was also a hand-made Civil War six-pounder cannon that was almost three feet long that had to sit on boxes between the display cases, along with a three-foot-tall radiocontrolled pirate ship.

Two scratch-built models were also of note: Glenn Bingham built an awesome 1/48-scale diorama depicting an OS2U-3 Kingfisher atop a catapult on a main gun turret of the battleship USS New Mexico BB-40. His entry won the Adult Best of Show ribbon. Gary Sinning entered an "Eagle Transporter" from the Space 1999 television show that was entirely scratchbuilt and was almost two feet long.
